After spring brush collection & fall leaf collection are completed, residents may utilize Renewed Outdoors for brush and leaf disposal. Check-In must be performed before disposal is allowed.

ITEMS ACCEPTED AT NO CHARGE

- Branches, brush, and bushes-NO rootballs
- Cornstalks
- Firewood
- Leaves
- Logs
- Ornamental grasses
- Straw (bales or loose)
- Stumps must be free of all dirt
- Stump grindings
- Wood mulch

Items NOT ACCEPTED

- Dirt or sod
- Ivy or vines
- Landscape timbers
- Lumber of any type
- Pallets
- Rocks or stone
- Wooden fencing
- Concrete

ITEMS ACCEPTED AND FEE CHARGED

- Garden debris/weeds from flower gardens
- Garden debris/weeds from vegetable gardens
- Grass clippings

\$7 per cubic yard will be charged, with a minimum of one yard Cash, check, credit and debit cards accepted

RENEWED OUTDOORS COMPOST SITE PROCEDURES

(Items must be separated into different piles at disposal, separation prior to arrival of materials is requested-mixed loads can be rejected if not separable)

KEEP THESE ITEMS TOGETHER

- Branches
- Brush
- Bushes
- Firewood
- Logs
- Stumps
- Stump grindings
- Twigs

KEEP THESE ITEMS TOGETHER

- Cornstalks
- Leaves
- Ornamental Grasses
- Straw
